The rates named in this tariff are for the transportation of refined petroleum products by pipeline, are governed, except as otherwise provided herein, by the rules and regulations published in Ohio River Pipe Line LLC's F.E.R.C. No. 75.2.0, and successive issues thereof.

For the East Sparta, Ohio to Heath, Ohio Movement only: Carrier will allow Specialty Products (as defined under the governing FERC Rules and Regulations Tariff No. [W] ~~75.1.0~~ 75.2.0 Item No. 4) to be transported, in addition to Refined Petroleum Products. Volume Incentive Rates for Refined Petroleum Products will not apply for Specialty Petroleum Product barrels.

For the Heath, Ohio to Harpster/Findlay, Ohio Movement only: Carrier will allow Specialty Products (as defined under the governing FERC Rules and Regulations Tariff No. [W] ~~75.1.0~~ 75.2.0 Item No. 4) to be transported on this route in addition to Refined Petroleum Products. Volume Incentive Rates for Refined Petroleum Products will not apply for Specialty Petroleum Product barrels.

Volume Incentive Rates for Refined Petroleum Products

~~[C] (1) An incentive tariff of 29.14 cents per barrel will be applied to all barrels shipped from Kenova, West Virginia to Columbus, Ohio in excess of 49,000 barrels per day during a calendar quarter.~~

[W] (2) (1) An incentive tariff of [U] 29.14 cents per barrel will be applied to all barrels shipped from Columbus, Ohio to Dayton, Ohio in excess of 10,000 barrels per day during a calendar quarter.

[W] (3) (2) An incentive tariff of [U] 29.14 cents per barrel will be applied to all barrels shipped from Columbus, Ohio to Heath, Ohio and/or from Heath, Ohio to Columbus, Ohio in excess of 6,000 barrels per day during a calendar quarter. Volumes can be combined for these movements to apply towards the 6,000 barrels per day required for the incentive tariff.

[W] (4) (3) An incentive tariff of [U] 29.14 cents per barrel will be applied to all barrels shipped from Heath, Ohio to Findlay, Ohio in excess of 4,000 barrels per day during a calendar quarter.

[W] (5) (4) An incentive tariff of [U] 29.14 cents per barrel will be applied to all barrels shipped from East Sparta, Ohio to Heath, Ohio and/or from Heath, Ohio to East Sparta, Ohio in excess of 8,000 barrels per day during a calendar quarter. Volumes can be combined for these movements to apply towards the 8,000 barrels per day during a calendar quarter.

[W] (6) (5) An incentive tariff of [U] 29.14 cents per barrel will be applied to all barrels shipped from East Sparta, Ohio to Midland, Pennsylvania and/or from Midland, Pennsylvania to East Sparta, Ohio in excess of 13,000 barrels per day during a calendar quarter. Volumes can be combined for these movements to apply towards the 13,000 barrels per day required for the incentive tariff.

[W] (~~7~~) (6) An incentive tariff of [U] 29.14 cents per barrel will be applied to all barrels shipped from East Sparta, Ohio to West Point, Ohio and/or from Midland, Pennsylvania to West Point, Ohio in excess of 7,000 barrels per day during a calendar quarter. Volumes can be combined for these movements to apply towards the 7,000 barrels per day required for the incentive tariff.

A calendar quarter is defined as January 1 through March 31, April 1 through June 30, July 1 through September 30 and October 1 through December 31. Barrels expire after each calendar quarter and cannot be carried forward.

Item No. 2 - Reverse Flow Operations

East Sparta, OH to Canton, OH

Normal operation will be Canton, OH to East Sparta, OH; however, when nominations from Canton, OH to East Sparta, OH are such that sufficient pumping time exists to reverse the line, Carrier will transport product from East Sparta, OH to Canton, OH at Shipper's request provided Shipper tenders a minimum batch of 10,000 barrels.

Heath, OH to Columbus, OH

Normal operation will be Columbus, OH to Heath, OH; however, when nominations from Heath, OH to Columbus, OH are such that sufficient pumping time exists to reverse the line, Carrier will transport product from Heath, OH to Columbus, OH at Shipper's request, provided Shipper tenders a minimum batch of 10,000 barrels.

Heath, OH to East Sparta, OH

Normal operation will be East Sparta, OH to Heath, OH; however, when nominations from East Sparta, OH to Heath, OH are such that sufficient pumping time exists to reverse the line, Carrier will transport product from Heath, OH to East Sparta, OH at Shipper's request provided Shipper tenders a minimum batch of 10,000 barrels.

~~An Exception to governing Rules and Regulations F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 75.2.0, and successive issues thereof, on Item No. 4, Specification of Commodities:~~

~~4. Specification of Commodities~~

~~(a) Refined Petroleum Products:~~

~~Refined Petroleum Products will be received for Transportation hereunder provided they are of good merchantable quality. This Specification includes those petroleum products commonly known as gasoline and diesel products (including, but not limited to, kerosene, aviation fuel, low sulfur diesel, high sulfur diesel, ULSD and diesel containing up to 5% blend of biodiesel).~~

~~(b) Methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE), ethyl tertiary butyl ether (ETBE), tertiary amyl methyl ether (TAME), or other aliphatic ethers will be prohibited within Refined Petroleum Products except under the following criteria:~~

~~(1) The de minimis limit of such aliphatic ether levels will not exceed 0.5% by volume at either the origin or destination points.~~

~~Market Solvent Yellow 124 is prohibited in Commodities.~~

~~(c) Carrier will, when required by subsequent pipelines or when product quality concerns arise, require Shipper to furnish a certificate setting forth in detail the specifications of each Commodity offered for Transportation to Carrier's pipeline or other facilities. Carrier will, at its discretion, sample and/or test any Commodities tendered for Transportation. In the event of variance between Carrier's test and Shipper's said certificate, Carrier's test shall prevail. If the Commodity does not meet Carrier's acceptance specification, Carrier may require the Origination Facility to re-designate the Commodity to another product.~~

~~Shipper shall provide Carrier with prompt notification of any tank switches that occur during the pump-out of Commodities from any Origination Facility.~~
