RE: Cathodic Protection Inspection

Dear Neighbor,

Marathon Pipe Line LLC (MPL) operates a pipeline system that crosses your property. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of upcoming activity on the right of way. MPL will be conducting Cathodic Protection Inspections as part of the continued monitoring and maintenance of this pipeline.

MPL, along with its contractor, will be conducting Cathodic Protection Inspections to assess the effectiveness of the cathodic protection system and as well as to comply with government regulations. The inspection involves accessing each test station (the white PVC pipe risers with yellow caps) along the pipeline and taking electrical measurements from the wire leads under the yellow caps. It typically takes a technician a couple of minutes to collect the data at each test station. The inspection **will not** require any digging and will not otherwise result in any damage to your property.

Due to the terrain of the right of way and location of the test stations, the survey crew may need to use a Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV) to access certain areas of the right of way. Should you have cattle or access constraints, please contact MPL at the general phone number or email address listed above. In addition, for the safety of our crew, it may be necessary for them to park their vehicles off the roadway on the right-of-way to avoid any vehicular traffic.

MPL plans to begin the Cathodic Protection Inspections the week of <<STARTDATE>> and completing the survey the week of <<ENDDATE>>. However, this timetable is subject to delay depending on the weather and other unexpected outside influences. Please contact tenants or lessees who may rent the land to advise them of MPL's upcoming survey.
