RE: In-Line Inspection

Dear Landowner,

Marathon Pipe Line LLC (MPL) operates a pipeline system that crosses your property. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the upcoming activity on the right-of-way (ROW).

As part of the continued monitoring and maintenance of this pipeline, MPL and its contractors will be conducting an In-line Inspection (ILI) to ensure integrity of the pipeline system and to comply with government regulations. Sophisticated and sensitive ILI tools travel inside of the pipeline and measure and record irregularities that may represent corrosion, cracks, laminations, deformations (dents, gouges, etc.), or other anomalies.

Above Ground Markers (AGMs) are required to catalog the location of the ILI tool as it travels inside of the pipeline. A two-person crew is necessary to set equipment at these AGM locations during the ILI. To allow the AGM locations to be accessed quickly during the inspection, the crew will benchmark the locations prior to the inspection by placing a survey stake at each AGM location. The ILI will not require any digging and will not otherwise result in any damage to your property. Due to the terrain of the ROW, the crew may need to use a Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV) to access certain areas of the ROW. We do not anticipate any land damage caused by the UTV; however, if land damage is present, please contact us at the phone number or email address above. In addition, for the safety of our crew, it may be necessary for them to park their vehicles off the roadway onto the ROW to avoid any vehicle traffic.

MPL plans on beginning the AGM benchmarking the week of <<START DATE>>, and completing the initial ILI runs the week of <<END DATE>>. Also, I wanted to call to your attention that the ILI runs 24 hours a day due to the nature of the inspection and crew could be parked at various times during inspection. I did not want you to be startled if you see a crew member on our ROW or along the road in the middle of the night. The above timetable is subject to delay depending on the weather and any other unexpected outside influences. Please contact any tenants or lessees who may rent the land to advise them that MPL will be conducting this Inspection.

In the months following the ILI runs, MPL will identify locations along the ROW to potentially excavate and further inspect the pipeline. A two-person staking crew will locate and mark these sites with wooden stakes while documenting pertinent information (pipeline depth, terrain, etc.). A ROW Specialist will contact you if additional work is required at the staked locations.

MPL takes great pride in the relationships we have built on trust with landowners like you, and with the communities in which we live and work. It is our goal to maintain good relations with all our neighbors, working with them in a fair and responsive manner.
