A. OVERVIEW

Marathon Pipe Line LLC (MPL) and Ohio River Pipe Line LLC (ORPL), subsidiaries of MPLX LP (www.mplx.com), hereby announce the commencement of a two-phase open season to solicit commitments from prospective shippers for transportation service on a proposed 50-mile pipeline (the "Cornerstone Pipeline") and other associated Utica Build-Out Projects (collectively the "Project"). MPL, as operator of ORPL, is seeking term financial commitments in order to underwrite the Project's significant capital investment. The estimated in-service date for the Cornerstone Pipeline is in late-2016 and the estimated in-service date for the other Utica Build-Out Projects is mid-2017.

Phase One, a non-binding open season, will provide prospective shippers an opportunity to quantify their interest in the Project. If sufficient interest is obtained through the Phase One non-binding open season, MPL will further develop the Project in preparation for a second phase of the open season. Phase Two, a binding open season, will provide prospective shippers the opportunity to submit offers to MPL for priority and non-priority transportation service through a Transportation Service Agreement (TSA).

MPL has designed the non-binding open season to include three scoping options for the Project, which are based on delivery locations, volumes and product types. All three scoping options are based on the sizing and design of the Cornerstone Pipeline. The Project will have the potential to provide pipeline transportation service for Specialty Products, which consist of condensate, natural gasoline, diluent and normal butane and their specifications are found in Appendix 3. Section B and Appendix 1 of this document provide additional details for each option by specifying which product types can be delivered to the various destinations.

If the Phase One non-binding open season results in sufficient shipper support for the Project, MPL will determine which Project option(s) to proceed with in a Phase Two binding open season. The Phase One non-binding open season will begin at 8:00 a.m. EDT on August 1, 2014 and conclude at 12:00 p.m. EDT on September 15, 2014. The Phase Two binding open season dates have yet to be determined.

B. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

Cornerstone Pipeline

MPL will build the 50-mile Cornerstone Pipeline to connect the MarkWest condensate stabilization facility, near Cadiz, Ohio and the Utica East Ohio (UEO) Harrison Hub fractionation facility, near Scio, Ohio to the Canton, Ohio refinery. The routing of the Cornerstone Pipeline

provides the opportunity for future connections to the MarkWest fractionation facility, near Hopedale, Ohio and the UEO cryogenic facility, near Leesville, Ohio. Additionally, the design of the Cornerstone Pipeline will provide for other potential connections to Utica Shale facilities, including the MPL-operated crude/condensate truck unload located at the Canton, Ohio refinery. The ultimate sizing and design of the Cornerstone Pipeline is dependent on total shipper interest of product types, volumes, and delivery destinations.

Utica Build-Out Projects

MPL, as operator of ORPL, is also advancing various other pipeline projects to provide service to additional markets beyond Canton, Ohio. These projects include new construction and utilization of existing ORPL pipelines. The existing ORPL systems currently transport refined petroleum products. Upon completion of certain expansion projects, the ORPL systems will have additional capacity that will be dedicated for condensate and/or natural gasoline. A detailed summary of the product types, origination locations, destination locations and volume commitments can be found in the options table identified in Appendix 1.

Additional Options

MPL is also exploring pipeline options to deliver condensate and diluent from the Utica Shale to the Chicago, Illinois area refineries and into pipelines that ultimately supply diluent to western Canada. While these specific projects are not included in the Phase One non-binding open season, MPL may include them in the Phase Two binding open season if there is sufficient shipper interest. More details for these options can be provided upon request.

C. OPEN SEASON PROCESS AND DOCUMENTS

Note - MPL is also evaluating long term normal butane storage options which would have additional storage fees beyond the pipeline tariff rates.

The MPC Wellsville, OH terminal is located on the Ohio River and has the ability to load stabilized condensate onto barges.

The MPC Midland, PA terminal is located on the Ohio River and has the ability to load natural gasoline onto barges.
