The rate named in this tariff is for trunk line transportation of crude petroleum by pipelines, subject to the Rules and Regulations published in Marathon Pipe Line LLC’s Tariff FERC No. 316.13.0, and reissues thereof.

[N] ¹An Incentive Rate of 147.29 cents per barrel will be offered when total monthly nominations are less than 256,000 light equivalent barrels per day, or as adjusted by operational factors. Shippers will be notified following the Nomination Date if the Incentive Rate will be in effect.

GATHERING CHARGES

The rate named herein is for trunk line transportation only and no gathering service will be performed under this tariff.

VISCOSITY SURCHARGE

In addition to all other charges for transportation hereunder, all crude petroleum having a viscosity in excess of 55 Saybolt Universal Seconds (SUS) at 60 degrees Fahrenheit (60°F) shall be subject to a surcharge of [U] 3.72 cents per barrel for 100 SUS units or portion thereof in excess of 55 SUS.
